Patco #5 Glass Cleaner.

Patco Recommends That While Cleaning Near Food or Food Contact Surfaces, Always Use the *Controlled Spray* Method. Hold the nozzle of the spray bottle next to a disposable paper towel to wet towel for cleaning. Do not spray directly on surface to be cleaned. This keeps the spray from drifting onto food or food contact surfaces. KEEP AWAY FROM CHILDREN!

Patco #5 Glass Cleaner is an industrial strength product used to clean restroom mirrors, sneeze guards, windows, cooler and freezer doors, gas pumps, hand soap and paper towel dispensers, pole sign numbers, floor displays, and neon tubes and signs.

Patco #5 glass cleaner contains only tiny percentages of the chemicals that other companies use to make them evaporate quickly. The professional cleaning strength in Patco #5 Glass Cleaner is a patented formula which uses a higher percentage of solids than is found in typical *home use* cleaning products.

Because of the unique formulation of Patco Glass Cleaner, it is not necessary to use large amounts of our product for cleaning purposes. Set the nozzle on your spray bottle for a fine mist, spray a small area, wipe the area dry and repeat.

***** Do not use white disposable cleaning cloths with Patco #5 Glass Cleaner. Patco recommends brown or blue paper towels to clean and dry your glass and plastic surfaces.**

In non-freezing conditions, dispense ½ gallon of Patco Glass Cleaner from the unit in your mop sink into a gallon bucket. Mix with ½ gallon of cool water and fill squeegee buckets at the fuel islands.
